- 10. Requires minimum sophomoreclassification
- 11. Prerequisite EHRD 203 and 210 with a grade of C or better, junior or seniorclassification
- 12. Requires junior or senior classification
- 13. Prerequisite EHRD 203 with a grade of C or better, MATH 140/141, 142; junior or seniorclassification
- 14. Prerequisite EHRD 371 with a grade of C or better; junior or senior classification

***Department policy states that 1) EHRD/TCMG 484 (Internship) must be taken in the student's final semester and 2) Students are limited to a maximum of 12 hours during internship semester, and all courses taken with internship must be in an online format.

Students must have completed 60 hours to register for 300/400 level courses

*Three hours of International and Cultural Diversity [UICD] and three hours of Cultural Discourse [KUCD] are required. Selection must be from courses on the approved list. Selection can be courses that also satisfy the requirement for Social and Behavioral Science, Creative Arts, Language, Philosophy and Culture, or electives.

Foreign Language Requirement -
